


## Brettzky's Hockey Challenge Guiding Principles & Procedures for Fund Requests

The following Guiding Principles will be taken into consideration when Brettzky's Hockey Challenge has been requested to donate funds:

- Organizations and groups will be primarily considered for donations. However, individual youths may also be eligible on a limited basis.
- Organizations and individual youths must be in the greater Viking area.
- Priority for donations will be given to organizations involved in youth sports and activities and individual youths involved in sports.
- Organizations who contribute to the wellness of the community and the quality of life of residents of the Viking area will also be given consideration.
- Donated funds must be used for a specific project or needs.
- Organizations receiving funds must provide recognition to the Brettzky's Hockey Challenge. This includes submission of a 15-30 second video clip of how you used your donation. Video clips will be used as promotion on our social media accounts and at the event.
- Funds must be used in 2022.
- Applications will be accepted until December 31, 2021. The Brettzky's committee will make decisions on donations by January 31, 2022.
- Organizations who receive funds will be expected to volunteer at the event.
- The person named as Contact on the application form will be required to come (or find a substitute) to the Volunteer Orientation Meeting in June 2022, provide the Brettzky's committee with a list of your volunteers and be the liaison the between the Brettzky's committee and your organization.
- If you receive funds and cannot use the funds for the intended purpose, please contact the Brettzky's Hockey Challenge committee.
